Our project WeNEETIabs is addressing digital transformation through development of digital readiness, resilience and capacity of young people, especially women, who have finished their education and seeking a job in social entrepreneur context. The goal is to create a framework where young women are supported in their social entrepreneurshiprelated job seeking journey through which they will be upskilled with the help of an online educational game, mentoring support and a job-searching portal.

On 22–23 of February 2023 our partners – Innovation Hive, Exeo Lab Srl, The Square Dot team, The Hub Nicosia Ltd and Folkuniversitetet Stiftelsen vid Lunds Universitetet - travelled all the way to Oslo and Oslo International Hub to have our first Transnational Meeting in person. We had the opportunity to go through the first milestones of the project and had fruitful discussions about the Pedagogical Methodology, Focus Group Guidelines and the Questionnaire.

During the first weeks of March 2023 our questionnaires have been shared to young NEET women, employers and educators in the field of social entrepreneurship in order to identify the gaps in knowledge, skills, and needs of social entrepreneurship education, digital literacy and job searching with young NEETS.
